#### Senate budget unveiled

The Senate Finance Committee on Tuesday unveiled its first round of changes to the biennial budget bill, [House Bill 33](#). Key changes to the bill include: increasing the minimum state share percentage from 5% to 10%; maintaining the fiscal year (FY) 2022 base cost inputs proposed by the House; revising the local capacity measure in a manner that drives less state aid to districts statewide; establishing universal vouchers while means-testing the voucher amounts for students in families above 450% of the federal poverty level; including [Senate Bill 1](#) - the ODE restructuring legislation; restoring the retention provision of the Third-Grade Reading Guarantee; and revising pupil transportation policies and the compliance monitoring system.

Senate President **Matt Huffman** and Senate Finance Committee Chairman **Matt Dolan** on Tuesday held [a press conference to discuss the Senate's budget changes](#) and answer media questions. Many questions focused on the school-funding formula, which provides a combined total of \$8.24 billion in FY 2024 and \$8.44 billion in FY 2025 to school districts and joint vocational school districts. The formula also cuts funding by \$245.6 million in FY 2024 and by \$295.8 million in FY 2025, compared to the House. Finally, it increases voucher spending by \$181.5 million in FY 2024 and by \$190.7 million in FY 2025, compared to the House. Over the biennium, the Senate plan spends \$541.4 million less on districts than the House while increasing voucher spending above the House's funding level by \$372.2 million.

The source of the funding reductions appears to be the bill's change to the local capacity measure, which currently is set at 60% on property valuation per pupil, 20% on federally adjusted gross income (FAGI) per pupil, and 20% on median-adjusted FAGI per pupil. The Senate removed the median-adjusted income element, making it entirely 40% FAGI per pupil. A reason for including a median-adjusted measure is to soften the impact of outlier high-income earners that may distort the wealth appearance of a district. Without that measure, districts suddenly appear wealthier and thus receive less state aid, which is occurring in the Senate formula. In defense of this policy shift, Dolan said, "All (the current capacity measure) did is make wealthy school districts look like they're less wealthy."

The Finance Committee will meet again mid-next week to accept a second round of changes via an omnibus amendment and vote on the bill. Then, the full Senate will vote on the measure on Thursday, June 15. The bill then returns to the House for a concurrence vote, a mostly pro forma vote in which House members customarily reject the Senate budget proposal to allow a six-member, bicameral conference committee further refine the spending plan and reconcile the differences between both chambers' versions of the bill.

However, recent intelligence indicates Senate President **Matt Huffman** has been dutifully working to whip votes among House members, encouraging them to concur with the Senate's changes and thus bypass a conference committee and cement the Senate budget in law without further modifications.

Top allies of House Speaker **Jason Stephens** contend this will not happen, saying they are preparing for a conference committee.

A summary of the changes made by the Senate in the substitute bill is accessible at the end of this newsletter. District-by-district simulations of the Senate formula compared to the House formula are accessible at the end of this newsletter as well.

#### **AOS announces voucher lawsuit survey participation; issues follow-up survey request**

Auditor of State **Keith Faber** on Tuesday announced only 38% of school officials responded to a permissive survey on their participation in the EdChoice voucher lawsuit. 417 of the available 1,108 school districts, educational service centers, and community schools responded to the Auditor's request by June 2. Faber issued a follow-up survey due today, June 9. "If we do not receive your response by June 9, we will formally request and take steps necessary to obtain the information," the survey notice stated. According to the AOS:

- 335 schools, or 30.2%, responded "no" on whether they are supporting the litigation.
- 35 schools, or 3.2%, responded "yes" on whether they are supporting the litigation.
- 47 schools, or 4.2%, responded "unsure" on whether they are supporting the litigation.
- 691 schools, or 62.4%, did not respond.

#### **Heard around the Statehouse**

## **Substitute House Bill 33 (As Pending in Senate Finance)**

### **Analysis of LSC 135 0001-5**

#### **6.6.23**

##### **I. School-Funding Formula**

- Maintains the House's updated data used to calculate the base cost in the formula from FY18 data to FY22 data and continues the phase-in percentages to be 50% in FY24 and 66.67% in FY25
- Provides a combined total of \$8.24 billion in FY24 and \$8.44 billion in FY25 to traditional school districts and joint vocational school districts
- Compared to the House, decreases spending by \$245.6 million in FY24 by \$295.8 million in FY25
- Increases the formula's minimum state share percentage for traditional school districts and joint vocational school districts from 5% to 10% in FY24 and FY25
- Modifies the formula's local capacity measure to be based on 60% of the district's valuation per pupil and 40% on the districts federal adjusted gross income (FAGI) per pupil, rather than 60% on valuation per pupil, 20% on FAGI per pupil, and 20% on adjusted FAGI per pupil
- Eliminates supplemental targeted assistance, a \$53 million annual payment for districts to mitigate potential losses resulting from changes in how students are counted in the current formula
- Replaces two guarantees – temporary transitional aid and formula transition supplement – with one guarantee – transitional aid – which ensures a district's foundation aid in FY24 and FY25 does not fall below its FY23 foundation aid
- For purposes of calculating targeted assistance payments, counts open enrollment students in the ADM of their educating school district, rather than their resident district
- Maintains the bill's spending and reporting requirements for Student Wellness and Success funds and Disadvantaged Pupil Impact Aid funds
- Does not modify the House's funding for educational service centers (ESCs)

##### **II. EdChoice Voucher Program**

- Establishes universal eligibility for the EdChoice Expansion Program by eliminating income requirements to receive a voucher under the program, which currently qualifies students with family income at or below 250% of the federal poverty level (FPL)
- Establishes a means-testing process to award full or partial voucher amounts based on family income so that students with a family income at or below 450% FPL (\$135,000 for a family of four) are eligible for the maximum voucher amount; students above that amount receive a reduced voucher amount based on a sliding scale with a minimum amount of \$617 for grades K-8 and \$841 for grades 9-12

- Increases the maximum voucher amounts to \$6,165 for grades K-8 and \$8,407 for grades 9-12
- Increases voucher spending by \$182 million in FY24 and \$191 million in FY25, with total spending across all voucher programs to be \$964 million in FY24 and \$1.04 billion in FY25
- Eliminates the House provision that would have prohibited private schools from requiring a student's parent to disclose, as part of the school's admission procedure, whether the student's family income is at or below 200% FPL, which is the threshold by which private schools may not charge tuition beyond the voucher amount
- Eliminates the requirement for ODE to develop measures that enable parents to effectively compare the performance of EdChoice voucher students against students enrolled in public schools

### **III. Pupil Transportation**

#### Transportation Compliance Monitoring System

- Modifies the Transportation Compliance Monitoring System, under which school districts are assessed financial penalties for noncompliance with transportation laws
- Revises the definition of noncompliance to be five consecutive school days or more than 10 school days within a school year, rather than [10 consecutive days or 10 cumulative days in a semester](#)
- Broadens the eligible offenses that contribute to a district being noncompliant to be (1) when students arrive more than 30 minutes late to school, (2) when students are picked up more than 30 minutes after the end of the school day, (3) when students do not receive any transportation at all, and (4) noncompliance with any other transportation law
- Modifies the noncompliance financial penalty to withhold a district's transportation payments for each noncompliance day and disburse the per-pupil daily amount of the district's transportation payment to parents of students who did not receive proper transportation while the district was noncompliant
- Requires noncompliant districts to submit a remediation plan to ODE, and requires ODE to resume transportation payments to the district once it determines the remediation plan is completed and the district is compliant
- Exempts days in which inclement weather caused noncompliance from counting towards the period of noncompliance

#### ESC Transportation Pilot

- Revises the ESC transportation pilot by applying it to the ESC of Central of Ohio and Montgomery County ESC; delaying the start date to the 2024-25 school year; requiring the ESC to arrange for buses and bus drivers and collaborate with participating schools on daily start and end times; and paying the ESCs the transportation funding amounts the applicable district otherwise would have received for transportation, among other changes

#### Impracticality Determinations and PILOT payments

- Requires determinations of transportation impracticality to be reevaluated at least every other year and be reconsidered in each year if a parent has a change of circumstances and requests transportation
- Increases the ceiling for a payment in lieu of providing transportation upon a finding of impracticality to \$2,500, rather than not more than the average cost average cost of pupil transportation for the previous year (currently \$1,077)

#### Other transportation provisions

- Eliminates the House provision that would have required districts to provide K-8 students

“substantially the same level of transportation service, route, and schedule convenience, and pick-up and drop-off times relative to the pupil's school's start and end times, regardless of whether the pupil attends a school operated by the board of education or a nonpublic or community school”

- Adds community schools, in addition to private schools, as schools whose students may be transported by school districts in nine-passenger vehicles
- Modifies the daily pre-trip school bus inspection rules by removing checks of the following equipment: (1) turbo charger, (2) alternator, (3) belts, (4) water pump, (5) power steering pump, (6) air pump, (7) any part of the steering system, (8) any part of the suspension, (9) any part of the air brakes, (10) any part of the brake equipment, including drums or rotors, (11) springs and spring mounts, and (12) air bags (these items will all be evaluated by the State Highway Patrol in their regular equipment inspections)
- Requires ODE to develop the Bus Driver Flex Career Path Model to create a pathway for bus drivers to work as educational aides or student monitor's at districts and schools and ensure that bus drivers work an eight-to-ten-hour shift on a morning or afternoon bus route and spend the remainder of the work day working as an educational aide or student monitor at a school
- Requires districts to provide transportation as a related service to students with disabilities who live in the district but attend a private school if the district is provided with supporting documentation in the student's individualized education program, individual service plan, or academic support plan

#### **IV. Educators**

- Maintains the House provision that modifies the teacher licensure grade bands to become preK-8 and 6-12, rather than preK-5, 4-9, and 7-12 as under current law
- Makes permanent the expiring provision that temporarily permits districts to hire substitute teachers without a post-secondary degree, provided they meet certain conditions, and establishes a one-year temporary substitute teaching license
- Eliminates the House provision that would have increased the minimum teacher salary from \$30,000 to \$40,000 and increased all other salary schedule elements by 33%
- Restores the executive version's funding for literacy to be \$174 million over the biennium
- Defines the Science of Reading as an interdisciplinary body of scientific evidence that: (1) informs how students learn to read and write proficiently, (2) explains why some students have difficulty with reading and writing, (3) indicates that all students benefit from explicit and systematic instruction in phonemic awareness, phonics, vocabulary, fluency, comprehension, and writing to become effective readers, and (4) does not rely on any model of teaching students to read based on meaning, structure and syntax, and visual cues, including a three-cueing approach
- Maintains the House provisions of House Bill 9 that modify the Ohio Teacher Residency Program and reduce the alternative resident educator license from four to two years, among other items
- Eliminates the House provisions that would have established (1) the Grow Your Own College Scholarship Program, a four-year, \$7,500 scholarship program for eligible teachers; and (2) the Teacher Loan Repayment Program, a five-year, \$40,000 maximum loan repayment program for eligible teachers
- Maintains the bill's provisions regarding pre-service teacher permits and student teaching
- Eliminates the House provision that would have required districts to provide one day of professional development leave for classroom teachers each year to observe a veteran teacher
- Exempts an applicant for a one-year nonrenewable out-of-state teaching license who passes Ohio's Foundations of Reading Exam on the first attempt from having to complete at least six of the required

12 hours of coursework in the teaching of reading

- Creates a K-12 grade band for computer science teaching licensure
- Maintains the House provision that would have permitted individuals with an alternative resident educator license to teach preschool students
- Eliminates the House provision that would have established an alternative military educator license to allow eligible military individuals to receive an educator license on an expedited timeline
- Permits a veteran employed as an unlicensed teacher to teach core subject areas
- Eliminates the House provision that would have required ODJFS to update its list of in-demand jobs to include teachers

#### **V. ODE Governance**

- Includes the provisions of Senate Bill 1, which creates the Department of Education and Workforce (DEW) and transfers most of the duties and responsibilities of the State Board of Education to DEW

#### **VI. Students**

- Permits students to substitute one-half unit of financial literacy instruction for one-half unit of social studies instruction to meet the financial literacy requirement for graduation
- Eliminates the House provisions that would have eliminated student retention under the Third-Grade Reading Guarantee and similar provisions contained in [House Bil 117](#)
- Lowers the minimum age to participate in the Adult Diploma Pilot Program from 20 to 18
- Eliminates the House provision that would have provided \$10 million for the Work-based Learning Incentive Program to pay public schools \$1,000 for each student participating in at least 250 hours of work-based learning
- Eliminates the House provision that would have required ODE to reimburse public and private schools participating in the federal meal programs an amount equal to the difference between the federal free meal reimbursement rate and the federal reimbursement for a reduced-price meal for each student eligible for a reduced-price meal and receiving a meal
- Eliminates the House provision that would have required public and private schools to provide a meal at no cost to a student who is eligible for a reduced-price meal

#### **VII. Dyslexia**

- Eliminates the bill's provision that would have required ODE to identify a tier one dyslexia screening measure by January 1, 2024, and make it available to public schools free of charge
- Eliminates the bill's provision that would have permitted districts to use such measure

#### **VIII. Online Learning**

- Eliminates the law regarding blizzard bag and online lesson plans and replaces them with a process by which school closures are made up through a virtual education delivery model, up to three days
- Prohibits waivers of the requirements associated with blended learning or operating an online learning school as part of an Innovative Education Pilot Program ([Noble LSD in February 2023 was awarded a waiver for this purpose](#))

#### **IX. College Credit Plus**

- Provides \$1.5 million in FY24 and \$3.5 million in FY25 to establish and administer a program to provide grants of at least \$1,000 to school districts offering new College Credit Plus courses taught in secondary schools by high school teachers with appropriate credentials

## **X. ODE Studies**

- Eliminates the three studies proposed in the executive version and House version regarding (1) economically disadvantaged funding and services, (2) access to all-day kindergarten, and (3) evaluation of Student Wellness and Success funds on certain areas
- Requires a state-contracted study of academically high-performing schools that serve a high concentration of vulnerable students and, based on the study's results, develop and share a guide of best practices with school districts

## **XI. School Facilities**

- Eliminates the House provision that would have extended, from 13 months to 16 months, the time during which the voters of a school district must approve bond and tax levies related to a school facilities project after OFCC grants conditional approval of the project.
- Eliminates the House provision that would have established the Accelerated Appalachian School Building Assistance Program, under which at least three school districts in Appalachia who have not been approved to receive assistance under the Classroom Facilities Assistance Program become eligible for such funding
- Eliminates the House provision that would have provided \$7.6 million in FY 2024 for certain facilities projects of the Sandusky City School District, including \$2.8 million for a new culinary facility and \$4.8 million for a new welding facility
- Eliminates the House provision that would have required OFCC to allocate at least 10% of its Exceptional Needs Program (ENP) funds each year for the maintenance, repair, or replacement of facilities of a school district that previously completed a project under which the 23-year half-mill maintenance funding requirement has lapsed
- Eliminates the House provision that would have established the Accelerated School Assistance Program, under which OFCC would fund 80% of an eligible school district's classroom facilities project (applies to Canfield City Schools only)
- Eliminates the House provision that would have provided \$1.4 million to the Medina County Career Center to construct a new fire training facility
- Reduces the House's proposed \$200 million funding to \$100 million for the Career-Technical Construction Program and ensures the funding is first allocated to equipment needs with the remainder allocated to construction projects that expand or establish career-technical education programs

## **XII. Assessments and Accountability**

- Eliminates the State Report Card Review Committee, which is required to be established on July 1, 2023, and issue a report on the state report card no later than June 30, 2024
- Requires public and private schools to provide by June 30 annually a student's parents with the student's score on any state assessment administered to the student in that year and requires a district or school to mail or email the scores to the student's parent or post them in an accessible, secure portal on the district's or school's website

## **XIII. Income Taxes**

- Reduces the highest income tax rate bracket 3.99% to 3.75% and the second lowest bracket from 3.226% to 3%, effective in tax year 2023
- Reduces the four brackets to two and establishes income tax rates of 3.5% and 2.75%, effective in tax year 2024

#### **XIV. Property Taxes**

- Restores the ability of school districts and local governments to place a replacement levy on the ballot
- Eliminates the House provision that would have indexed the homestead exemption to inflation
- Maintains the House provision that would have established an eight-year property tax exemption on unimproved land subdivided for residential development
- Removes the piggyback state LIHTC tax credit, restores language authorizing a county auditor to value LIHTC property using an income approach, and requires OHFA to annually prepare a list of all federally subsidized rental property in the state
- Prohibits the Tax Commissioner from giving greater weight to sales data in any of the last three years when performing studies of real estate appraisals
- Eliminates the House provision that would have created the Joint Committee on Property Tax Review and Reform

#### **XV. Sales Taxes**

- Creates a \$1 billion expanded sales tax holiday to occur in August 2024

#### **XVI. Sports Gaming Taxes**

- Restores the executive version's provision that increases the sports gaming receipts tax rate from 10% to 20%
- Eliminates the law's earmark that requires one-half of the sports gaming revenue to be allocated to schools to reduce or eliminate pay-to-play and extracurricular activity fees and instead allocates all revenue to support the school-funding formula and voucher program

#### **XVII. Miscellaneous Education Provisions**

- Eliminates the House provision that would have required public and private schools to transmit a transferred student's records within five school days after receiving a request from the school or district that the student is attending
- Requires each district to report in EMIS the number of students attending a school within the district other than the one normally assigned, and requires districts with an enrollment lottery for intradistrict enrollment to conduct the lottery on the second Monday of June in the school year prior to the school year for which the student is seeking enrollment
- Maintains the House provision that requires public and private schools to create an individualized seizure action plan for each student who is diagnosed with a seizure disorder, and requires a school nurse, or other district employee, to coordinate seizure care at the school and ensure that all staff receive training every two years in the care of students with epilepsy and seizure disorders
- Requires public and private schools with students in grades 6-12 to provide free feminine hygiene products to those students for use on school premises, requires each district or school to determine where such products are kept in the school, and provides \$5 million in FY24 for these efforts
- Requires districts to allow individuals to pay cash for tickets to athletic events, plays, musicals, or any other school-related events and establishes regulations to implement this policy
- Eliminates the House provision that would have required coaches of athletic activities at public and private schools to complete a state-approved student mental health training course and modified the frequency of frequency of the required sudden cardiac arrest training and youth concussion training
- Requires school districts to develop an education plan for a child who is eligible for the Autism Scholarship Program based on an autism diagnosis but who does not have an individualized education program



- Maintains the bill's provision that requires the issuance of certificates to private school administrators, supervisors, and teachers who hold a master's degree, without further educational requirements
- Prohibits school districts from denying a nonpublic school's request for personnel to provide auxiliary services who are properly licensed by a state board or agency
- Prohibits, between August 1, 2023, and June 30, 2025, all full-time DEW employees from working at their place of residence for more than eight hours per week
- Eliminates the bill's funding that would have provided \$7.5 million annually to support school-based centers in high-need counties
- Adds an exception to the current-law prohibition against members of a board of education having a financial interest in a contract into which the district enters when the contract is with a private institution of higher education that employs a board member, and requires the board member to recuse from voting on and discussing the contract and to file an affidavit stating the member's employment status
- Creates the "One Time Strategic Community Investment Fund," which will utilize \$1 billion in surplus revenue funding to support one-time expenses for various capital improvement and other projects
- Increases, from 8.5% to 10%, the amount of the GRF revenues for the preceding fiscal year intended to be maintained in the Budget Stabilization Fund (Rainy Day Fund), currently totaling \$3.48 billion

## H.B. 33, In Senate Finance, Traditional School District Foundation Aid and Additional Aid Estimates, FY 2024-FY 2025

Estimates are based on enrollment as of the first payment for January 2023 for traditional school districts and valuation and income projections supplied by the departments of Taxation and Education, respectively. Projected ADM does not change from FY 2023 to FY 2024 to FY 2025. Additional Aid represents special education transportation funds, preschool special education funds, and career awareness and exploration funds. Actual aid will be calculated based on actual data and is subject to change. The primary purpose of these estimates is to determine a state total obligation. Changes between estimates and actual aid may be significant, especially for individual school districts.
